Holy Communion on Sunday 1 November 2020

Please have these prepared and with you prior to the service commencing, and only prepare enough for what you (and members of your household) will need. Any leftovers are to be consumed in a reverent manner after the service. I know this is not the same as being physically gathered together in church but we are spiritually gathered as the body of Christ. Christ is present in the Word and in our coming together for worship. There is no obligation for you to participate. Many of you will not be able to do so, because you cannot access the worship services online. I wish this could be different but unfortunately the options are limited. Everyone in our Parish needs to be held in prayer, and with love and compassion, as we continue in fellowship and in mission.
