Bottles & cans - Eligible 10c items can be put in the machine at the Sanctuary carpark.

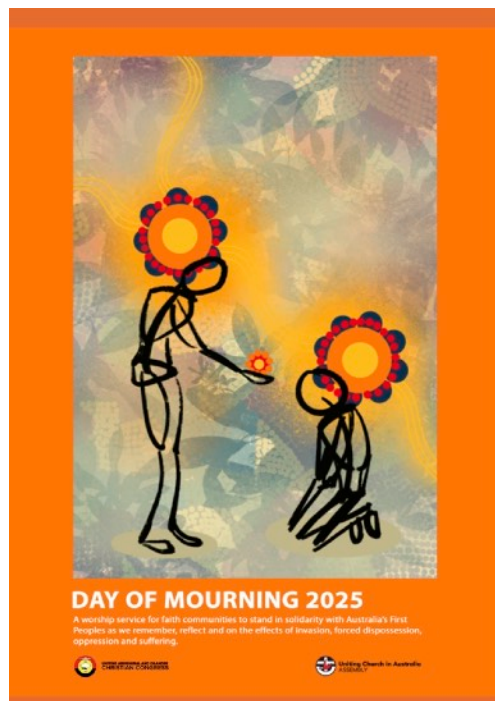
